Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 13 and on the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 164.99 feet South and 1255.23 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument, West of San Antonio Avenue, and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $5^{\circ} 42'$  119.34 feet along Lot 13;
2.  $98^{\circ} 20'$  93.45 feet along Lot 11;
3.  $179^{\circ} 33'$  135.88 feet along Lot 9;
4. Thence along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, on a curve to the right having a radius of 280.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $300^{\circ} 15' 30''$  11.60 feet;
5. Thence still along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street on a curve to the left, having a radius of 170.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $284^{\circ} 36'$  98.55 feet to the point of beginning.
