Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 17 and on the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 179.57 feet South and 1428.17 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument, West of San Antonio Avenue, and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $9^{\circ} 21'$ 129.9 feet along Lot 17;
2. $98^{\circ} 20'$ 78.45 feet along Lot 15;
3. $188^{\circ} 40'$ 130.30 feet along Lot 13;
4. Thence along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, on a curve to the right having a radius of 705.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $278^{\circ} 38'$ 80.00 feet, to the point of beginning.
