Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 14 and on the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 179.57 feet South and 1428.17 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument, West of San Antonio Avenue, and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the South side of Auwaiolimu Street, on a curve to the right, having a radius of 705.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $284^{\circ} 56' 30''$  75.00 feet;
2.  $9^{\circ} 14'$  121.26 feet along government land (Chinese Cemetery);
3.  $98^{\circ} 20'$  74.90 feet along Lot 16;
4.  $189^{\circ} 21'$  129.90 feet along Lot 14 to the point of beginning.
