Beginning at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 9 and on the North side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 80.11 feet South and 828.0 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 186° 25' 142.4 feet along Lot 9;
2. 279° 40' 55.42 feet along near the edge of the South bank of the Pauoa Stream;
3. 355° 50' 129.4 feet along Lot 11;
4. Thence along the North side of Auwaiolimu Street on a curve to the right having a radius of 160 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 87° 44' 30" 80.0 feet to the point of beginning.
