Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 12 and on the North side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 61.17 feet South and 976.95 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the North side of Auwaiolimu Street on a curve to the left having a radius of 320 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $77^{\circ} 27' 30''$ 65.94 feet;
2. Thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 160 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $72^{\circ} 24' 30''$ 4.87 feet;
3. $175^{\circ} 50'$ 129.4 feet along Lot 10;
4. $254^{\circ} 11'$ 71.45 feet along near the edge of the South bank of the Pauoa Stream;
5. $355^{\circ} 50'$ 133.1 feet along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.
