Beginning at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of L.C.A. 7775 Apana 4, to Kahuaina, and on the North side of Auwaiolimu Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 158.56 feet South and 1505.86 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument West of San Antonio Avenue, and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Streets, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2531, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the North side of Auwaiolimu Street on a curve to the left, having a radius of 745.0 feet the direct azimuth and distance being:
102° 29' 30" 127.5 feet;
2. 166° 14' 103.75 feet along the East side of a 15 foot right-of-way to cemetery;
3. 250° 00' 120.2 feet along L.C.A. 1350 Apana 1, to Kamamaka, to a pipe;
4. 347° 56' 173.3 feet along L.C.A. 7775 Apana 4, to Kahuaina, to the point of beginning.
