Beginning at an iron bolt at the North corner of this lot and the South corner of Lusitana and Miller Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 29.48 feet North and 30.35 feet West of a Government Survey Street Monument South of Miller Street and at the intersection of the tangents of the center line of Lusitana Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along the West side of Lusitana Street on a curve to the left having a radius of 603.7 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:-  
348° 57' 70.45 feet;
2. 72° 23' 91.4 feet along Lot 2;
3. 162° 05' 70.0 feet along Lot 3;
4. 252° 23' 99.8 feet along the South side of Miller Street to the point of beginning.
