Beginning at the South corner of this lot and the North corner of Alapai and Prospect Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning being 27.56 feet North and 23.21 feet East of a Government Survey Street Monument at the intersection of the center lines of Prospect and Iolani Avenues and the North line of Alapai Street, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2530, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $163^{\circ} 45'$ 155.25 feet along Prospect Avenue;
2. Thence on a curve to the right along Prospect Avenue with a radius of 776.55 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being $166^{\circ} 43' 30''$ 80.66 feet;
3. $240^{\circ} 21'$ 157.68 feet along J. P. Rodrigues' lot;
4. $307^{\circ} 04'$ 139.90 feet along U. S. Military Reservation;
5. $40^{\circ} 06' 30''$ 289.58 feet along Alapai Street to the point of beginning.
