1. 208° 58' 141.6 feet along Road A to an iron pin;
2. 299° 41' 153.8 feet along Executive Order No. 40, Agricultural Experiment Station, dated March 28, 1921 (Lot 913, Waiakea Homesteads, 2nd Series) to a stake;
3. 29° 41' 141.6 feet along same;
4. 119° 41' 152.0 feet along Camp Site 5-B to the point of beginning.
