Station "Halai" being 20350.5 feet South and 8422.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2650, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 92° 01' 85.0 feet along Road A to a stake;
2. 175° 40' 80.0 feet along Lot 1009, Waiakea Homesteads 2nd Series to a pipe;
3. 265° 40' 84.5 feet along same;
4. 355° 40' 89.4 feet along Camp/7 to the point of beginning.
