Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at the west corner of this lot the south corner of Lot 2 and on the northeast side of Government Main Road the true azimuth and distance from Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2" pipe in concrete) being  $143^{\circ} 23' 78.00$  feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1.  $143^{\circ} 23'$  65.58 feet along the northeast side of Government Main Road;
2.  $233^{\circ} 23'$  200.0 feet along Lot 2 to corner of two Road Reserves;
3.  $30^{\circ} 13'$  197.54 feet along the northwest side of Road Reserve;
4.  $86^{\circ} 48'$  22.03 feet along the northeast side of Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
