Beginning at a pipe at the West corner of this lot, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu Pahu" being 1608.9 feet South and 2840.6 feet West, and the true azimuth and distance from said pipe to a concrete post on the boundary of Heeia and the land of Kanohuluiwi is 59° 23' 158.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2334, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 224° 50' 630.0 feet along South side of 40 foot road reserve to a pipe at the West corner of Lot 2;
2. 339° 00' 984.5 feet along Lot 2 to a pipe on the North bank of Keeahala Stream;
3. Thence along the bank of the Keeahala Stream to a pipe on the North bank of same and on the East line of 50 foot reserve for the Government Road, the direct azimuth and distance being: 91° 51' 620.7 feet;
4. 159° 00' 484.5 feet along 50 foot road reserve for Government Road to the point of beginning.
