Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 2, and on the West side of road (30-feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1681.3 feet North and 1248.3 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 85° 49' 133.8 feet along Lot 2, to a pipe set in concrete;
2. 179° 49' 95.5 feet along Lot 3, to a spike set in concrete;
3. 272° 38' 144.4 feet along Grant 5599 to M. K. Makekau to a spike set in concrete;
4. 7° 31' 79.7 feet along road 30-feet wide to the point of beginning.
