Palolo Homesteads,

Waiomao, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at "I" marked on set stone at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 2, on the East side of the Palolo Valley 50 Foot Road, the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" being $201^{\circ} 16'$ 1350.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $310^{\circ} 00'$ 1550.0 feet along Lot 2 to edge of pali, the boundary between Waiomao and Kapahulu;
2. $104^{\circ} 16'$ 346.0 feet along edge of pali along Kapahulu to Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina 2" (marked by  on stone and ahu), the true azimuth and distance to Trig. Station "Makanui" being $170^{\circ} 28' 30''$ 2198.9 feet and to "Rocky Hollow" Trig. Station being $192^{\circ} 49' 30''$ 4388.1 feet;
3. $81^{\circ} 49'$ 520.0 feet along edge of pali along Kapahulu to a place called "Paina";
4. $124^{\circ} 10'$ 826.0 feet down pali along Kapahulu to end of stone wall at foot of pali;
5. $137^{\circ} 07'$ 128.0 feet along stone wall along Kapahulu to Government Survey Trig. Station "Waiomao" (marked by  on large solid rock in wall), the true azimuth and distance to "Makanui" Trig. Station being $208^{\circ} 43' 30''$ 1921.6 feet and to "Wailupe" Trig. Station being $179^{\circ} 33' 30''$ 2114.5 feet;
6. $130^{\circ} 45'$ 103.5 feet along stone wall along Kapahulu to  on solid stone in wall on the East side of 50 Foot Road;
7. $226^{\circ} 18'$ 190.0 feet along the East side of Palolo Valley 50 Foot Road;

8. Thence still along the Palolo Valley Road, on a curve to the right having a radius of 548 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $236^{\circ} 30'$ 192.0 feet;
9. $246^{\circ} 18'$ 47.5 feet along the East side of the Palolo Valley Road;
10. Thence still along the East side of the Palolo Valley Road, on a curve to the left having a radius of 598 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being: $241^{\circ} 30'$ 102.0 feet;
11. $236^{\circ} 18'$ 97.5 feet along the East side of the Palolo Valley Road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom portion of L.C.A. 8287 to Kawainui and portion of 30 Foot Homestead Road within this lot, leaving a net area of 16.1 ACRES.
