

Beginning at a spike in concrete at the Northwest corner of this lot, and the Southeast corner of Pala Lane (20 feet wide) and Wilder Road (30 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaumana" being 14.44 feet South and 3278.90 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2922, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 270° 21' 100.00 feet along the South side of Pala Lane to a spike;
2. 360° 00' 125.00 feet along Lot 15, Kaumana House Lots, to a spike;
3. 90° 21' 100.00 feet along Lots 18 and 17, Kaumana House Lots, to a spike, and passing over a spike at 50.0 feet;
4. 180° 00' 125.00 feet along the East side of Pala Lane to the point of beginning.

AREA 12,500 SQUARE FEET

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way, 10 feet wide, for the storm ditch across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 440 Square Feet, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 12060 SQUARE FEET.
