Beginning at a spike in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 2 and on the North side of Kalaniana'ole Avenue (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 6066.02 feet North and 18656.02 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2869, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 61° 58' 149.96 feet along the North side of Kalaniana'ole Avenue (50 feet wide) to a spike in concrete;
2. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 40.34 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being: 134° 59' 77.16 feet to a spike in concrete;
3. 208° 00' 208.00 feet along the Southeast side of Keaukaha Road to a spike in concrete;
4. 331° 58' 190.00 feet along Lots 3 and 2, passing over a spike in concrete at 55.0 feet, to the point of beginning.
