Beginning at a galvanized iron spike and ahu at the Southeast corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 4, on the West side of Hinano Avenue, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai", being 223.0 feet South and 9591.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2566, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 90° 00' 225.0 feet along Lot 4 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
2. 180° 00' 100.0 feet along Lot 1 to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
3. 270° 00' 225.0 feet along the South side of Pillani Avenue to a galvanized iron spike and ahu;
4. 360° 00' 100.0 feet along the West side of Hinano Avenue to the point of beginning.
