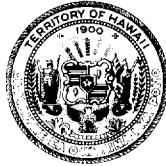

4. 270° 00' 223.00 feet along the south side of Hualani Avenue to the point of beginning.

Please be informed that by exchange deed dated March 23, 1943, Mrs. Luisa Ah Choy, wife of Lum Ah Choy, conveyed to the Territory for the realignment of Hawaii Belt Road Parcels 17, area 3,366 sq.ft., 17-A, area 5,885 sq.ft., and 17-B, area 826 sq.ft., of Federal Aid Project No. 26-A, situate at Kainehe, Hamakua, Hawaii, as shown on your C.S.F. 9789-9791, in exchange for which the Territory conveyed to Mrs. Ah Choy Lot 2, area 22,300 sq.ft., of Block 23 of the Waiakea House Lots Tract, 1st Series, situate at Waiakea, South Hilo, Hawaii, as shown on blueprint on file in your office in Carton No. 151, Island of Hawaii.

Said instrument is recorded on pages 256-265 of Liber 1755 and is on file in this office under No. 7379.
