Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 1, and on the West side of road (30-feet wide) the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1681.3 feet North and 1248.3 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 7° 31' 80.0 feet along road (30-feet wide) to a pipe set in concrete;
2. 79° 09' 124.9 feet along North side of road (30-feet wide) to a spike set in concrete;
3. 179° 49' 93.1 feet along Lot 4, to a pipe set in concrete;
4. 265° 49' 133.8 feet along Lot 1, to the point of beginning.
