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Beginning at a galvanized iron spike at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 22, and on the South side of Leleiwi Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5402.47 feet North and 25983.01 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2730 and running by true azimuths:-

1. Thence along Leleiwi Road on a curve to the left with a radius of 979.9 feet the chord azimuth and distance being $255^{\circ} 06'$ 91.18 feet;
2. $342^{\circ} 26'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 24;
3. Thence along government land on a curve to the right with a radius of 1179.9 feet the chord azimuth and distance being: $75^{\circ} 06'$ 109.8 feet;
4. $167^{\circ} 46'$ 200.0 feet along Lot 22 to the point of beginning.
