Beginning at a concrete monument at the East corner of this lot, and on the Southwest boundary of Executive Order No. 174 (U.S. Naval Reservation) the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5083.3 feet North and 15859.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2539, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 48° 30' 225.3 feet along government land to a concrete monument;
2. 138° 30' 21.3 feet along Hilo Railroad Company's Right-of-Way (50 feet wide) to a pipe;
3. 64° 25' 48" 14.6 feet along same to the East side of a 16-Foot Road;
4. 161° 34' 20.1 feet along the East side of a 16-Foot Road;
5. 183° 01' 16.4 feet along same;
6. 196° 45' 41.9 feet along same;
7. 220° 37' 17.3 feet along same;
8. 249° 30' 50.8 feet along same;
9. 139° 22' 276.0 feet along 16-Foot Road and along Lot 1, Keaukaha Seaside Lots, to a spike, passing over a spike in the center of said road at 8.5 feet;
