Beginning at a spike in concrete at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 1 and on the North side of Kalaniana'ole Avenue (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 6966.02 feet North and 18656.02 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2869, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 151° 58' 135.00 feet along Lot 1 to a spike in concrete;
2. 241° 58' 216.88 feet along Lot 3 to a spike in concrete;
3. 360° 00' 76.64 feet along West side of 40-Foot Road to a spike in concrete;
4. Thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 127.07 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being: 30° 59' 130.83 feet to a spike in concrete;
5. 61° 58' 68.70 feet along North side of Kalaniana'ole Avenue (50 feet wide) to the point of beginning.
