Beginning at an iron pipe at the North corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 4, Block 303, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 6051.1 feet South and 8166.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $328^{\circ} 10'$ 180.0 feet along the West side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
2. $58^{\circ} 10'$ 242.0 feet along Lot 2, Block 303, to an iron pipe;
3. $148^{\circ} 10'$ 180.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
4. $238^{\circ} 10'$ 242.0 feet along Lot 4, Block 303, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 01/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 99/100 ACRE.
