
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 4, Block 503, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9231.8 feet South and 9249.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along West side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 2, Block 503, to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 511-A to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 4, Block 503, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 02/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 98/100 ACRE.
