Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to William Henry,  
of the Keaahala Homesteads, Kaneohe, Oahu.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this piece, on the South-west side of a 20 foot road, the same being the North corner of Lot 4, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "COOLIDGE" being 994.8 feet South and 1637.2 feet West, and running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:-

1. 34° 02' 307.4 feet along Lot 4 to a pipe;
2. 85° 30' 76.0 feet along Lot 5 to a pipe;
3. 73° 15' 112.0 feet along Lot 5 to a pipe;
4. 214° 13' 444.6 feet along Lot 2 to a pipe;
5. Thence curving to the right with a radius of 80 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being 297° 13' 29.3 feet; to a pipe;
6. 307° 46' 100.0 feet along the South-west side of a 20 foot road to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 48,073 square feet.
