Beginning at a spike in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 2 and on the West side of 40-Foot Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 6287.11 feet North and 18784.00 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2869, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $61^{\circ} 58'$ 216.88 feet along Lot 2 to a spike in concrete;
2. $151^{\circ} 58'$ 55.00 feet along Lot 1 to a spike in concrete;
3. $208^{\circ} 00'$ 130.88 feet along the Southeast side of Keaukaha Road to a pipe in concrete;
4. Thence along same on a curve to the right with a radius of 199.70 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being: $228^{\circ} 07'$ 137.37 feet to a pipe in concrete;
5. $248^{\circ} 14'$ 57.69 feet along South side of Keaukaha Road to a pipe in concrete;
6. $360^{\circ} 00'$ 175.26 feet along the West side of 40-Foot Road to the point of beginning.
