LOT 3 BEING A PORTION OF THE GOVERNMENT LAND

OF WAHIAWA: WAIALUA: OAHU: H. I.

Commencing at the south corner of this lot at a red-wood post on the north edge of avenue (80.feet wide) adjoining Lot 2. & running;-

1. N.23° 17'W.true 1887.feet along Lot 2.to a redwood post on side of Wahiawa gulch;
2. S.84° 17'E.true 645.feet along Grant 606 to A.S.Cooke in Wahiawa to a red-wood post on south edge of Wahiawa gulch
3. S.84° 17'E.true 1392.feet along portion of Wahiawa, sold to Galbraith by Board of Education, to a red-wood post on south edge of gulch;
4. N.41° 20'E.true 1392.feet along same to a red-wood post on south edge of gulch. From this point the Government Survey Station Maili bears N.68° 58'W.true, Maunauna Station bears S.53° 55'W.true and Kokoloea Station bears S.43° 45'W.true.
5. N.55° 31'E.true 1000.feet along same to a red-wood post on south edge of gulch; thence -
6. S.29° 55'E.true 1340.feet along Lot 5.B. to a red-wood post on the north edge of a dry gulch and on edge of road.
7. S.36° 33'E.true 1128.feet along road to a red-wood post;
8. S.66° 43'W.true 1065.feet along avenue (80.feet wide) to a rock marked with a cross. From this rock the government Survey Station Kokoloea bears S.54° 43'W.true; Thence-
9. S.66° 43'W.true 2587.feet along avenue to initial point.
