Beginning at an iron pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 3, Block 303, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 6051.1 feet South and 8166.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 58° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 3, Block 303, to an iron pipe;
2. 148° 10' 180.0 feet along government land to an iron pipe;
3. 238° 10' 242.0 feet along Lot 5, Block 303, to an iron pipe;
4. 328° 10' 180.0 feet along the West side of "Road 1 West" to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.
