Waiakea, South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron pipe at the South corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 3, Block 402, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 7441.8 feet South and 9359.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $152^{\circ} 45'$  150.8 feet along Lot 17, Block 402, to an iron pipe;
2.  $238^{\circ} 10'$  242.0 feet along Lot 5, Block 402, to an iron pipe;
3. Thence along the West side of Volcano Road, on a curve to the right having a radius of 1185.8 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $332^{\circ} 45'$  189.5 feet to an iron pipe;
4.  $67^{\circ} 20'$  242.0 feet along Lot 3, Block 402, to the point of beginning.
