Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 5, Block 803, on the West side of "Road 1 West", the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 14556.5 feet South and 9653.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along West side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 3, Block 803, to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 804-A to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 5, Block 803, to the point of beginning.
