Part A of Lot 4.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot, which is the South corner of Grant 2632, at a post and pile of stones, the coordinates of said point from Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapoho" being: South 14850.2 feet, and West 17005.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2071, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 233° 34' 1091.0 feet along Grant 2632;
2. 213° 46' 289.0 feet along Grant 1535 to a cocoanut tree at East corner of Grant 1535 at trail;
3. 351° 30' 255.5 feet along Government land (Malama);
4. 53° 34' 1319.0 feet along Part B of Lot 4;
5. 139° 31' 50.4 feet along Government land (Malama);
6. 189° 11' 111.0 feet along 15 foot road reserve to the initial point.
