Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, which is the Northwest corner of Lot 5, at a post and pile of stones, the coordinates of said point from Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapoho" being: South 15106.1 feet and West 16898.6 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2071, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $139^{\circ} 31'$ 142.2 feet along Government land (Malama);
2. $233^{\circ} 34'$ 1319.0 feet along Part A of Lot 4;
3. $351^{\circ} 30'$ 160.5 feet along Government land (Malama);
4. $53^{\circ} 34'$ 1234.0 feet along Lot 5 to the initial point.
