the abandoned 30-Foot Roadway between the original
Lots 4 and 5

Being a portion of the Government Land of Kaniahiku

Beginning at a pipe in concrete at the south corner of
this lot, the west corner of Lot 5, Kaniahiku House Lots and
on the north side of the Government Main Road, the coordi-
nates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey
Triangulation Station "PAHOA" being 4325.03 feet South and
7365.78 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered
Map 3019, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from
True South:-

1. 106° 30' 256.49 feet along the north side of the
Government Main Road to a spike
in concrete;
2. 196° 30' 509.49 feet along the east side of 30-Foot
Roadway (1941) to a spike in
concrete;
3. 286° 30' 256.49 feet along government land of Kaniahiku
to a spike in concrete;
4. 16° 30' 509.49 feet along Lot 5, Kaniahiku House Lots
(Grant 10719 to Kiyomu Watarida) to
the point of beginning.
