Beginning at a stake at the North corner of this lot and on the South side of the Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said stake referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Ma" being 170.4 feet South and 2447.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2000, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 296° 05' 234.0 feet along the South side of homestead road to a stake;
2. 311° 35' 440.0 feet along the South side of homestead road;
3. 43° 50' 584.5 feet along the Northwest side of a 40 foot road;
4. 29° 30' 360.5 feet along the Northwest side of a 40 foot road;
5. 123° 49' 50.0 feet along Government land to a Forest Reserve Monument;
6. 186° 02' 64.5 feet along Government land to a stake;
7. 172° 24' 355.0 feet along Government land to a pipe;
8. 122° 59' 450.0 feet along Government land to a pipe;
9. 228° 38' 667.0 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning.
