Palolo Homesteads,

Waiomao, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at a solid rock marked "IV" between this lot and Lot 5, being 156 feet West of 30 Foot Homestead Road, from which the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" is $129^{\circ} 04' 30''$ 1020.0 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $310^{\circ} 00'$ 1228.0 feet along Lot 5 and up pali to the top of the ridge between Waiomao and Waialae Nui;
2. Thence along top of ridge along Waialae Nui, the direct azimuth and distance being: $29^{\circ} 04'$ 446.3 feet;
3. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 1450.0 feet along Lot 3 to a solid rock marked "III", 100 feet West of 30 Foot Homestead Road, from which the true azimuth and distance to "Makanui" Trig. Station is $155^{\circ} 18'$ 969.0 feet;
4. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 180.0 feet along Lot 3 to large rock marked "III" in Waiomao Stream;
5. Thence up the center of Waiomao Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: $241^{\circ} 55'$ 472.3 feet;
6. $310^{\circ} 00'$ 141.0 feet along Lot 5; (at 8 feet from center of said stream passing over solid rock marked "IV" on East bank), to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom portions of L.C.A. 8290, Ap. 1 and 2 to Kinoua and that portion of 30 Foot Homestead Road (0.25 acre) within this lot, leaving a net area of 13.3 ACRES.
