Being a portion of the Government Land of Keonepoko Iki

Beginning at a spike and stonepile at the south corner of this lot, the west corner of Lot 3, and on the northeast side of the Government Main Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Reference Station "Village Flag" (marked by a 2" pipe in concrete) being 134.84 feet North and 100.21 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2370, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 143° 23' 50.0 feet along the northeast side of the Government Main Road to a spike and stonepile;
2. 233° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 5 to a spike and stonepile;
3. 323° 23' 50.0 feet along the southwest side of Road Reserve to a spike and stonepile;
4. 53° 23' 200.0 feet along Lot 3 to the point of beginning.
