Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Waiakea

Beginning at a pipe in concrete at the southeast corner of this ^{Lot} being also the northwest corner of Lihiliho and Luka Streets, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HALAI" being 2917.00 feet North and 10,574.01 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2835, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 90° 00' 145.11 feet along the north side of Lihiliho Street (60 feet wide) to a pipe;
2. 180° 00' 75.00 feet along Grant 8610 to Kanaaukahi to a pipe;
3. 270° 00' 145.11 feet along Lot 3, Block 4, Waiakea-Kai Lots;
4. 360° 00' 75.00 feet along the west side of Luka Street, to the point of beginning.
