Description of Center Line of Trail
through Lot 4 of Lualualei Homesteads,
Lualualei, Waianae, Oahu.

Beginning at a point on the East side of 60 foot main homestead road, the true azimuth and distance to + on stone at the Northwest corner of this Lot 4 and the Southwest corner of Lot 3 being: $168^{\circ} 35'$ 1259.1 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2165, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $249^{\circ} 26'$ 173 feet;
2. $237^{\circ} 02'$ 162.0 feet;
3. $245^{\circ} 24'$ 252.0 feet;
4. $237^{\circ} 37'$ 745.0 feet;
5. $237^{\circ} 03'$ 313.0 feet;
6. $226^{\circ} 43'$ 420.0 feet;
7. $206^{\circ} 00'$ 217.0 feet;
8. $231^{\circ} 10'$ 175.0 feet;
9. $222^{\circ} 49'$ 185.0 feet to a point on the boundary between Lots 3 and 4; from this point the true azimuth and distance to + on stone at the Northwest corner of Lot 4 and the Southwest corner of Lot 3 is $82^{\circ} 15'$ 2351.7 feet.
