
Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 6, Block 502; the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9209.9 feet South and 9541.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 7, Block 502, to an iron pipe;
2. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along West side of Volcano Road to an iron pipe;
3. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 3, Block 502, to an iron pipe;
4. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 6, Block 502, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 04/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 96/100 ACRE.
