Palolo Homesteads,

Waiomao, Palolo Valley, Kona, Oahu.

Beginning at "V" marked on set stone between this lot and Lot 6, being 314 feet West of 30 Foot Homestead Road, the true azimuth and distance from said marked stone to Government Survey Trig. Station "Makanui" being $105^{\circ} 13'$ 1198.6 feet, the true azimuth to "Rocky Hollow" Trig. Station being $184^{\circ} 15'$ and to "Paina 2" Trig. Station being $23^{\circ} 09'$ as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2293, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $310^{\circ} 00'$ 1210.0 feet along Lot 6 and up pali to the top of the ridge between Waiomao and Waialae Nui;
2. $45^{\circ} 55'$ 488.6 feet along top of ridge along Waialae Nui;
3. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 1228.0 feet down pali and along Lot 4 to "IV" marked on solid rock, 156 feet West of Homestead Road, from which the true azimuth and distance to "Makanui" Trig. Station is $129^{\circ} 04' 30''$ 1020.0 feet;
4. $130^{\circ} 00'$ 141.0 feet along Lot 4, (passing over solid rock marked "IV" on East bank of Waiomao Stream at 133 feet) to center of Waiomao Stream;
5. Thence up center of Waiomao Stream along Lot 14 to \dagger on large rock in stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: $224^{\circ} 44'$ 479.5 feet;
6. $171^{\circ} 00'$ 11.0 feet up stream to "V" marked on rock in stream;
