## WAIHAOLE HOMESTEADS.

Koolaupoko, Oahu.

Lot No. 5.

Beginning at a hill known as Kuolani whose coordinates from Government Trig. Station Puu Kauai are 4138.4 feet W. and 472.4 feet S. and from which Makikiki bears N 41° 31' 30" W true and Kiolea N 77° 19' 15" E true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2196, and running by true bearings:-

1. N 33° 3' W 488.8 feet along Forest Reservation to  $\dagger$  on a stone at  
146-17  
the Government Trig. Station Kuolele;
2. N 65° 54' 30" W 891.0 feet along Forest Reservation, across a small  
114-05-30  
ravine to a stake on ridge;
3. S 72° 13' W 1061.4 feet along Forest Reservation to a stake;
4. N 37° 35' E 340.4 feet along Forest Reservation to a redwood post,  
217-30  
at the Southwest corner of L.C.A. 8187B:1, Kuhia;
5. N 38° 24' W 330.0 feet along L.C.A. 8187B:1, Kuhia, to a redwood  
141-26  
post;
6. N 58° 26' E 100.3 feet along L.C.A. 8187B:1, Kuhia, to a redwood  
238-26  
post on the South bank of the Waiahole Stream;
7. N 4° 4' E 151.9 feet to a concrete post set for the Southwest  
184-04  
corner of Grant 411, L.L.McCandless; thence the  
boundary follows the course of the Waiahole

Stream to a redwood post at the North corner of  
L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina, the direct bearing and  
distance being:

8. N  $75^{\circ} 26' 40''$  E 2442.6 feet;
9. S  $38^{\circ} 45'$  W 330.0 feet along L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina, to a redwood  
post;
10. S  $8^{\circ} 20'$  E 66.0 feet along L.C.A. 10231:1, Mahina, to a redwood  
post;
11. S  $25^{\circ} 5'$  E 717.1 feet along Lot No. 4 to stake on ridge;
12. S  $30^{\circ} 13'$  W 953.1 feet along Lot No. 4 to the initial point.
