Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 502, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 9209.9 feet South and 9541.1 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No.2600, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 355° 40' 180.0 feet along Lot 5, Block 502, to an iron pipe;
2. 85° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 4, Block 502, to an iron pipe;
3. 175° 40' 180.0 feet along the East side of "Road 1 West" to an iron pipe;
4. 265° 40' 242.0 feet along Lot 8, Block 502, to the point of beginning.

AREA 1 ACRE.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 20 feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an Area of 12/100 Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 88/100 ACRE.
