Beginning at a red wood post at the East corner of this lot and the intersection of Kainalu and Mokolea Roads, the coordinates of said red wood post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Mokapu" being: 20940.8 feet South and 1432.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2502, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 57° 24' 270.12 feet along the Mokolea Road to a galvanized iron pipe;
2. 125° 39' 70.2 feet along the land of Kaelepulu to a stake;
3. 222° 52' 252.88 feet along Lot 5 to a stake;
4. 305° 39' 138.5 feet along the Kainalu Road to the point of beginning.
