Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the North corner
of this piece, on the West side of a 20 foot road, the same being
the South-east corner of Lot 5, the coordinates of said point of
beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station
"COOLIDGE", being 1352.5 feet South and 1511.9 feet West, and
running by true azimuths from the above described initial point:

1. Thence curving to the left with a radius of 80 feet, the direct
azimuth and distance being 265° 24'
1191 feet to a pipe;
2. 33° 17' 227.2 feet to a pipe;
3. 62° 45' 649.3 feet to a pipe;
4. 190° 44' 327.0 feet to a pipe;
5. 253° 20' 545.2 feet along Lot 5 to the point of beginning, and
containing an area of 138,800 square feet.
