Beginning at a galvanized iron spike at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 70 and on the North side of Leleiwi Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5436.90 feet North and 25887.10 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2730 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 173° 06' 179.23 feet along Lot 70;
2. 289° 05' 81.63 feet along government reserve;
3. 347° 46' 140.06 feet along Lot 68;
4. Thence along Leleiwi Road on a curve to the right with a radius of 929.9 feet, chord azimuth and distance being 80° 26' 86.53 feet to the point of beginning.
