Beginning at the west corner of this lot, the south corner of Lot 8 and on the northeast side of Haunani Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "VOLCANO HOUSE FLAG" being 3978.80 feet North and 5831.15 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 3088, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 239° 31' 341.1 feet along Lot 8;
2. 329° 31' 140.8 feet along Lot 12;
3. 59° 31' 341.1 feet along Lot 6;
4. 149° 31' 140.8 feet along the northeast side of Haunani Road to the point of beginning.
