Beginning at a galvanized iron spike at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 71 and on the North side of Leleiwi Road (50 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 5432.17 feet North and 25714.29 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2730 and running by true azimuths:-

1. Along Leleiwi Road on a curve to the right, with a radius of 929.9 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:  $96^{\circ} 26' 86.53$  feet;
2.  $189^{\circ} 06'$  191.74 feet along Lot 73;
3.  $266^{\circ} 40'$  69.12 feet along same;
4.  $3^{\circ} 46'$  203.48 feet along Lot 71 to the point of beginning.
