Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 5, and on the North side of road (30-feet wide) the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1701.0 feet North and 875.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 97° 40' 85.0 feet along road (30-feet wide) to a spike set in concrete;
2. 187° 40' 136.2 feet along Lot 9 to a spike set in concrete;
3. 284° 38' 85.6 feet along Grant 3150 to Kualau and L.C.A. 8531 Ap. 1 to Kalua to a spike set in concrete;
4. 7° 40' 125.8 feet along Lot 8 to the point of beginning.
