Being a portion of Lot 8, Grant 6174 to William Henry
of the Keaahala Homesteads and Grant 9313 to
F. James.

Beginning at a 3/4" galvanized iron pipe at the West
corner of this piece, on the North-east side of a 20 foot road,
the same being the South corner of Lot 7, the coordinates of
said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangula-
tion Station "Coolidge" being 979.0 feet South and 1624.3 feet
West, and running by true azimuths from the above described
initial point:

1. 188° 35' 390.4 feet along Lot 7 to a pipe;
2. 236° 05' 96.6 feet along the South side of a 20 foot
road;
3. 326° 05' 359.1 feet along Lots 12, 13 and 14 to a pipe;
4. 56° 05' 336.4 feet along Lot 9-B and Lot 9-A to a pipe;
5. 127° 46' 75.10 feet along the North-east side of a 20 foot
road to the point of beginning and
containing 90,604 square feet;
excepting and reserving therefrom that
portion of the Government Homestead
Road passing over and across this lot.
