Beginning at a spike set in concrete at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 12, and on the North side of road (30-feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kaneahuea" being 1723.2 feet North and 711.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2813, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 179° 53' 134.3 feet along Lots 12 and 11 to a spike set in concrete;
2. 269° 17' 57.1 feet along L.C.A. 9507 Ap. 2 to Maikowai to a spike set in concrete;
3. 284° 38' 43.1 feet along Grant 3150 to Kualau to a spike set in concrete;
4. 7° 40' 136.2 feet along Lot 7 to a spike set in concrete;
5. 97° 40' 81.0 feet along road, (30-feet wide) to the point of beginning.
